Given the confidential nature of the vast majority of agreements reached between our clients and other parties within their supply chain, we have kept the client identities confidential but have shared a number of recent sustainable supply chain provisions negotiated, on behalf of our clients, into commercial contracts:

## **GLOBAL CONFECTIONARY BUSINESS:**

Drafting and Negotiating specific contractual provisions, for suppliers to meet demand which enhance our clients social values to incentivise the employment of people with disabilities throughout the supply chain.

## **FTSE 100 MANUFACTURING BUSINESS:**

Drafting and Negotiating sustainable supply chain audit provisions within contracts particularly in relation to social auditing.

## **FTSE 100 MANUFACTURING BUSINESS**

Drafting and Negotiating contractual provisions requiring suppliers to ensure equal opportunities for all working in their factories globally, with a particular focus on the upskilling and development of women working within factories within the global supply chains.

## **MAJOR HIGH STREET CLOTHING DISTRIBUTOR:**

Drafting and Negotiating contractual obligations on all over seas partners to ensure that any unsold stock is disposed of in an environmentally friendly way.

## **FTSE 100 GLOBAL DRINKS MANUFACTURER:**

Drafting and Negotiating contractual provisions to ensure that all paper products supplied throughout the supply chain use recycled materials.

## **GLOBAL CONFECTIONARY BUSINESS:**

Drafting and Negotiating specific contractual provisions to reduce waste within the supply chain. Notably, by introducing a requirement on suppliers that downgraded products made during production should be used for animal feed, with specific steps on how to turn the product into suitable feed and avoid waste disposal.
